The Cleveland Alumnae Panhellenic Association (CAPA) is offering non-restrictive \$1,500 grants, in aid for the 2010-2011 academic year, to sorority women in need of financial assistance.

Eligibility Criteria

1. Be a freshman, sophomore, junior or senior (requiring a fifth year for completion of her major) attending an accredited 4-year college/university.
2. Be an initiated member in good standing of a National Panhellenic Conference fraternity that is in good standing with the Cleveland Alumnae Panhellenic Association.
3. Graduated from a high school in the Greater Cleveland area and has a permanent residence in the same Greater Cleveland area which includes the counties of Cuyahoga, Geauga, Lake, Lorain, Medina, Portage, Summit and Ashtabula.
4. Have a grade point average sufficient to maintain good standing within her sorority.
5. Demonstrate financial need.
6. Demonstrate on-going involvement in her sorority.
7. Provide two recommendations (Current chapter members or relatives excluded):
 - a. The Chapter Advisor or other alumnae member of the Advisory Board
 - b. Current Faculty member or employer

How to Apply

1. Obtain application materials (3 page application and 2 recommendation forms) from the Cleveland Alumnae Panhellenic Association Web site <http://clevelandpanhellenic.org>, your Chapter President, Chapter Advisor, or Panhellenic President
2. Complete the forms thoroughly, neatly and on time.
3. Return the three (3) page application and two (2) sealed recommendations and a University Transcript to:
